Because... You can apply for support from the DKG International Educators Foundation for a project or for a Cornet Individual Professional Development or Seminar Award.

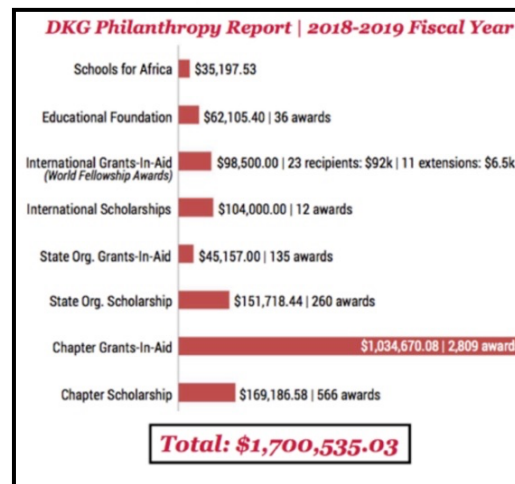
Because... You will be the recipient of leadership training and opportunities at all levels of the society

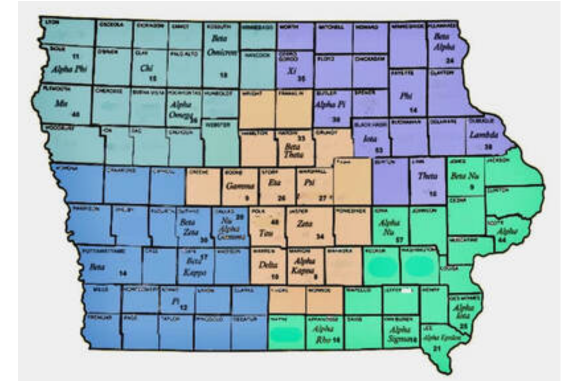


WHAT IOWA DKG IS DOING?
